Fairburn Celebrates Hispanic Heritage Month Theme: Heritage In Focus (September 15 - October 15)

Opening September 14th, *Heritage in Focus: Portraits of Fairburn* features large-scale photos by Ibarra-Rizo, showcasing the often-overlooked contributions of Fairburn's working-class residents. Suspended in the downtown alleyway, the monumental portraits feature individuals like a young man selling aguas frescas and the local hair salon owner, bringing visibility to their stories and the cultural richness they bring to the community.

Heritage in Focus: Through the Lens is a one-day screening curated by Ibarra-Rizo, debuting on **September 29th at the Southside Theatre Guild**. It features three powerful films by Hispanic filmmakers Darryl Richardson, Diana Larrea, and Adan Gabriel Perez-Ruiz, delving into themes of identity, struggle, and resilience, offering audiences a profound look into contemporary life within marginalized communities, while also serving as a platform for advocacy and reflection.

FAILURE TO APPEAR AMNESTY MONTH

The City of Fairburn Municipal Court will be conducting a Failure to Appear Amnesty Month, running from September 1 through September 30, 2024. During this period, individuals with outstanding traffic citations will have the opportunity to clear their records without facing additional penalties.

This special amnesty period allows anyone with unresolved traffic violations to pay their fines and have all penalties waived. We encourage all affected individuals to take advantage of this chance to resolve their cases without incurring extra costs.

To participate, simply visit the Fairburn Municipal Court or pay online during the month of September. This is a limited-time offer, so don't miss the opportunity to start fresh and avoid further legal complications.
